Requirements:

- Class A CDL License with endorsements for Class B and Class C
- Transport, deliver and retrieve construction/material handling equipment
- Operate commercial or non-commercial vehicle in a safe and efficient manner
- Ensure proper paperwork & logs are maintained accurately
- Perform equipment inspections upon delivery and retrieval of equipment
- Inspection of delivery truck for defects and safe operating condition, before, during, and after delivery trips
- Ensure all delivery documents, are properly maintained during the workday and are available for inspection upon request by management and or state traffic safety officers (for CDL drivers)
- Apply knowledge of driving and/or commercial driving skills in maneuvering at various speeds in difficult locations, heavy traffic, inclement weather, mountainous terrain, or tight loading dock areas
- Secure construction equipment and other equipment, by means of chaining, strapping, and blocking under the strict accordance and established procedures (CDL Drivers)
- Maintain open communication with Service Manager/Service Coordinator for delivery schedules
- Observe safety rules and regulations at Atlantic Lift Systems, customer job sites, and work related facilities
- Provide training assistance for customers by answering general questions regarding the safe operations of vehicles, tools, or machinery when asked by customer
- Report to the Service Manager during the equipment delivery/retrieval process
- Report all accidents involving driver or company equipment to Service Manager
- Promptly report any delays due to breakdowns, weather, traffic conditions, or any other problem relating to timely pickups or delivery of equipment
- Maintain flexibility in daily routine to aid Atlantic Lift Systems in responding to customer demands
